

Dementia Australia – Giving Tuesday Raffle 2024

- 1) Information provided by Dementia Australia on how to enter forms part of the terms and conditions of entry.
- 2) Purchase of a raffle ticket is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions by the person whose name is either completed on the ticket or the person identified as a gift recipient.
- 3) Where a ticket in the competition is purchased as a gift for and/or on behalf of another person (gift recipient), the purchaser of the ticket is deemed to be acting as an agent for the gift recipient and the gift recipient will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.
- 4) These terms and conditions apply to all entries into and/or prizes in the competition.
- 5) All proceeds from the raffle tickets will be donated to Dementia Australia.

WHO CAN ENTER?

- 6) Entry is open to all permanent residents of NSW, ACT, QLD, TAS and VIC, aged 18 years or older. WA, NT, ACT and SA residents are not eligible to enter.
- 7) Employees, directors or officers of Dementia Australia, any companies or agencies associated with this raffle are ineligible to purchase raffle tickets.

HOW TO ENTER

- 8) Raffle ticket sales will commence on Tuesday 26 November 2024 at 12:00pm (AEDT) and conclude on Tuesday 3 December at 11:59pm (AEDT) ("Promotion Period").
- 9) Each ticket costs \$10, and if two or more tickets are purchased within the same transaction, tickets will be discounted. Tickets may not be sequential.
- 10) Refunds of tickets are generally not accepted. If a refund is endorsed by Dementia Australia. Refunds cannot be issued after the prize is drawn.

- 11) To enter, entrants must, during the Promotion Period:
 - i) purchase a raffle ticket/s online via <https://fundraising.dementia.org.au/raffle/giving-tuesday-2024> and
 - ii) provide their contact details (first name, last name, residential address, valid email address and mobile phone number) in the section provided.
- 12) Dementia Australia will issue an e-ticket, for each ticket purchased, which may be printed by the recipient, together with the ticket receipt. No paper tickets will be issued.
- 13) No late entries will be accepted. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be ineligible.
- 14) Entrants are not restricted or limited to the number of raffle tickets which may be purchased during the Promotion Period.

If the date of the draw needs to be changed, due to circumstances causing a delay, Dementia Australia will advise all entrants by email of the new draw date. Entrants need not be present to win.

- 22) The winner will be notified by phone and in writing via email, and the winner's details will be published on the Dementia Australia website, <https://fundraising.dementia.org.au/raffle/giving-tuesday-2024> within two days of the draw date.
- 23) Dementia Australia reserves the right to request the winner to submit proof of identify, at the discretion of Dementia Australia, and their ticket receipt as proof of purchase.
- 24) In the event that there is any doubt or dispute as to the identity of the winner or as to the manner in which the prize is to be paid then the matter will be referred to Dementia Australia CEO (or delegate) for resolution.
